## SUMMER 2019



St James's Conservation Trust was formed in 1998 as a result of concern for the unique fabric of St James's, which was seen as under threat from inappropriate development and pressure to increase licensing hours. Since then, it has worked closely with The Crown Estate, Westminster City Council and other relevant organisations. St James's has the country's highest density of listed buildings and is one of the most interesting and eclectic areas of London, still maintaining its 17th century street grid system. It is therefore crucial that any development is sympathetic to the area and this is carefully monitored by the Trust, which endeavours to promote high standards of planning and architecture. The Trust works hard to secure the preservation, protection, development and improvement of features of historic and public interest, creating awareness of the history and impressive architecture of St James's. The Trust also maintains the character and atmosphere of the area with its social fabric, independent shops, craftsmen and private members' clubs.
